



PEE WEE Baseball Rules & Regulations

1. All team members can be on the field at one time. Two (2) pitcher helpers, one (1) catcher, three (3) base players, one (1) short stop, and one (1) player between first and second base for a total of eight (8) players being allowed in the infield. All other players must be on the outfield side of the baseline.

2. All team members will bat in order. The inning will end when 3 outs are accomplished **OR** each player on the team has had an opportunity to bat, whichever comes first. A total of six (6) pitches will be thrown to each batter, after which the batter will be called "out" if the ball has not been hit. A fouled 6th pitch is an out.

3. Time will be called when the pitcher receives the ball. At this point the runners can no longer proceed to another base. The only exception will be if the runner is already halfway to the next base before this occurs. This is the coach's judgment call. If not halfway, the runner will need to return to the previous base.

4. Games will be played according to the published schedule. Playing time will be 5 Innings or 50 minutes, whichever comes first.

5. HAVE FUN!!! Make it a great experience for the kids.
